At the end of the spring 2014 semester, Hillary Callihan will have completed all required coursework for the Preliminary Multiple Subject Credential and the Preliminary Education Specialist Credential with a Mild/Moderate Authorization as of May 16, 2014. This professional education program meets California's standards for teaching English learners. Campus courses are directly related to two semesters of supervised field experiences (teaching practica), culminating with a teaching performance assessment completed by all candidates.

All students completing this program have verified Subject Matter Competence (CSET passed) as approved by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing. In addition, all students completing this program meet the standards for "highly qualified teachers" for No Child Left Behind compliance.

It is the responsibility of the student to submit a credential application, all documentation (including passing scores for RICA: Reading Instruction Competence Assessment), and fees to the CSU, Chico Credential Analyst. When grades are posted in June 2014, the application and final transcript will be reviewed. If everything is in order, the application will be forwarded with the University's recommendation to the Commission on Teacher Credentialing in Sacramento, who will approve the application and issue the credential.
